Day 1 September 22, Tuesday: Depart USA

Depart Chicago O'Hare International Airport for our overseas journey to Munich, Germany.

Complimentary meals and beverages will be served aloft. (D,B)

Day 2 September 23, Wednesday: Arrive in Munich | Oberammergau

Arrive at Munich International Airport. Proceed through Passport Control, claim our luggage, and a Peter's Way tour manager will meet us as we exit Customs. Board our private touring bus and we will be on our way for an orientation ride of Munich, the capital of Bavaria and the second largest city in Germany. We will stop by the Marienplatz with its world-famous Glockenspiel and the Marian column which represents Munich's oldest memorial to peace. See the twin-towered Frauenkirche, hallmark of the Bavarian capital. Continue on to Oberammergau or Garmisch area for hotel check-in.

Dinner and overnight at hotel near Oberammergau. (D)

Day 3 September 24, Thursday: Attend the Oberammergau Passion Play

Buffet breakfast at hotel. After breakfast, **celebrate Mass at a local church.** Continue to Oberammergau, home of the world-famous Passion Play. The play dates back to 1633 when the Plague, the "Black Death", took a severe toll of lives in the small village. In their distress, the inhabitants turned to God and vowed that if the pestilence were taken from them, they would perform a play every ten years, depicting the suffering and death of the Savior. Their plea was heard and there were no further plague victims in Oberammergau. The first performance of the Passion play took place in 1634 in the village cemetery. This afternoon, attend the Passion Play in the renowned open-air theatre. The greatest story ever told comes to life as this superb production unfolds against a scenic backdrop of wooded mountains. The play begins with Christ's Entry into Jerusalem and the drama continues with the story of Christ's Passion, Death and Resurrection. The accompanying music is magnificent, and a full English translation of the script is available for you to follow from your reserved seat. All the town members partake in this play every 10 years.

There are two parts of the performance:

Part I: 2:30 pm to 5:00 pm

Part II: 8:00 pm to 10:30 pm

The dinner break lasts three hours (dinner is included with Oberammergau arrangements).

Overnight at hotel near Oberammergau. (B,D)

Day 4 September 25, Friday: Neuschwanstein Castle | Salzburg

Buffet breakfast at hotel. This morning, **celebrate Mass at the Wieskirche.** This pilgrimage Church of Wies is an oval Rococo church designed in the late 1740s by brothers J.B. and Dominikus Zimmermann. After Mass, we will go to King Ludwig's majestic Neuschwanstein Castle, the King's former residence. This white dream-like fortress was built 1869 by sketches of a theatrical decorator that explains this atmosphere. Go back to the times of Wagner as you visit the royal apartments decorated with scenes from German sagas and operas, the throne rooms, and music halls, with fine candelabra and chandeliers, King Ludwig's unique bedroom with artistic wood carvings and an artificial Grotto that recalls opera themes of his former friend and composer Richard Wagner. Independent lunch. Continue to the Baroque city of Salzburg, a jewel set on the beautiful banks of the Salzach River, for a two-night stay. Check-in at hotel.

Dinner and overnight at hotel in Salzburg. (B,D)

Day 5 September 26, Saturday: Sound of Music Sites | Evening Rehearsal at Salzburg Cathedral

Buffet breakfast at hotel. Begin our day with a visit to the village of Oberndorf to see the Silent Night Chapel which marks the place where the beloved Christmas carol was first performed on Christmas Eve in 1818. Continue to Leopoldskron to see the façade of the castle which appeared as part of the Trapp

home in the famous film, *The Sound of Music*. Continue on to the Austrian Lake District, and visit the Basilica in Mondsee where the wedding of Maria and Captain von Trapp was filmed. Enjoy St. Gilgen on Lake Wolfgang, a lakeside town which offers one of the best known landscapes of the Salzkammergut. See the Mozart fountain on the Mozartplatz in St. Gilgen which shows the young Mozart playing the violin, surrounded by birds spouting water. Independent lunch. This afternoon, enjoy a guided tour of Salzburg's sights along Getreidegasse, the city's pedestrian street, lined with authentic 17th and 18th century buildings including the house where Mozart was born. View Monchsberg with the fortress "Hohensalzburg," which overlooks the city. Built into the side of Monchsberg is the Salzburg Festspielhaus, home of the famous Salzburg Festival Operas. See Residenzplatz, the center square of Salzburg, dominated by the dynamic sculpture of the Residenzbrunnen, the largest Baroque fountain north of the Alps. The Residenz building, built in 1596, was once the palace of the Bishops. Nearby stands the Cathedral dating from 1614. Visit St. Peter's Abbey, next to the cemetery portrayed in *The Sound of Music* and where many of Mozart's religious works premiered. Independent dinner.

Evening (choir members only): Choir rehearsal with Prof. Janos Czifra, Director of Music of Salzburg Cathedral.

Overnight at hotel in Salzburg. (B)

Day 6 September 27, Sunday: Mass at Salzburg Cathedral | Vienna | Evening cruise on the Danube

Buffet breakfast at hotel. Morning **transfer to the Cathedral for 10:00 am Sung Mass with the Cathedral Choir and Orchestra, conducted by Prof. Janos Czifra. St. John Cantius Church Choir members may participate.** (*Mozart - Credo Missa KV 257 or Mozart's Missa Brevis in C, (KV 220 - Spatzenmesse - publisher Bärenreiter*). After Mass, we will have a photo opportunity at Cathedral Square. Independent lunch. This afternoon, we leave Salzburg for Vienna, the city of Mozart, Beethoven, Brahms, and Strauss!

Check-in at hotel for our three-night stay. **This evening, enjoy a cruise on the Danube River.** Relax on board and watch the landscape, while passing sights such as the Danube Tower, Millennium Tower, the Ring Tower, the District Heating Plant Spittelau, the Urania Observatory, and many others. Experience navigating through one or two of the locks as the boat is raised or lowered. On our cruise tour we will experience "green Vienna" with the forests of the Viennese Prater, in contrast to the new city skyline and historical Vienna.

Dinner and overnight at hotel in Vienna. (B,D)

Day 7 September 28, Monday: St. Stephen's Cathedral | Highlights of Vienna

Buffet breakfast at hotel. This morning, we will visit St. Stephen's Cathedral, Austria's most eminent Gothic edifice which houses a wealth of art treasures. The architectural history begins in the 12th century, the oldest remaining parts date from the 13th century: the Giant Gate (Riesentor) and the Towers of the Heathens (Heidentürme), both Romanesque in style. The South Tower (Südturm), at 448 feet, was completed in 1433 (the Viennese have given it the nickname Steffl, which also denotes the whole cathedral). During the 18th century, the cathedral was decorated with Baroque altarpieces - the panel of the main altar shows the stoning of its namesake St. Stephen, the first martyr of Christendom.

Independent lunch. Enjoy an orientation tour of Vienna. Pass by the Hofburg Palace, winter residence of the Habsburg emperors; the Capuchin Church containing the imperial vaults; St. Charles' Church, a splendid example of late Baroque architecture; and the Belvedere Palace, former residence of Prince Eugene of Savoy. Drive around the Ring Strasse, one of the most magnificent boulevards in the world, passing the Vienna Opera, Museums, House of Parliament, City Hall, and the Burgtheater. Independent dinner.

Overnight at hotel in Vienna. (B)

Day 8 September 29, Tuesday: Schonbrunn Palace | Farewell Dinner

Buffet breakfast at hotel. This morning, we will tour the Schonbrunn Palace, the summer residence of the Habsburgs. The castle was built by Ferdinand II in 1637 and came into its full grandiose incarnation during the reign of Maria Theresa, when she added the massive mirrors, frescoed ceilings and majestic crystal chandeliers. Independent lunch.

Optional afternoon visits on your own might include: Mozart house and Museum or the House of Music. Haus der Musik is an interactive discovery museum located in the heart of Vienna's first district nestled between St. Stephen's Cathedral and the Vienna State Opera. A host of interactive installations allow you to conduct the Vienna Philharmonic from a virtual conductor's podium, and the musicians on the screen will tell you if you are up to par. Journey back in time to see the great composers of the past, such as Mozart, Straus, Beethoven and others.

This evening, enjoy a special farewell Heurigen dinner with entertainment at a restaurant in Grinzing Zum Martin Sepp.

Overnight at hotel in Vienna. (B,D)

Day 9 September 30, Wednesday: Return to the USA

Buffet breakfast at hotel. Late morning, we will be transferred to Vienna airport for our return flight to the USA. (B)

Acceptance of these Terms & Conditions, with signature on enrollment form, is required for participation in this tour.

PAYMENT: Deposits and insurance payments will be accepted in the form of check, money order or credit card. **Participants who submit payments entirely by personal check will receive a \$100 per person discount.** Peter's Way Tours reserves the right to increase package price or reduce services accordingly should there be an escalation in the Euro valuation over the U.S. Dollar in excess of 3% from print date. If final payment is not received by the balance deadline, Peter's Way Tours reserves the right to cancel your reservation. If for any reason payment is received within 21 days of departure, a charge for express mailing of final documents will apply. A \$50.00 late payment fee and possible increase in airfare may apply for late payments. Personal checks will not be accepted within 30 days of departure. If the bank has returned a personal check, a \$25.00 processing fee will apply and subsequent payments must be made in the form of money order, certified bank check or credit card.

CANCELLATIONS/NON-REFUNDABLE PAYMENTS: The enrollment deposit and each subsequent payment are nonrefundable upon receipt. Cancellation at any time will result in the loss of 100% of all payments made per person including departure taxes & fuel surcharges, single supplement, deviation fees, travel insurance payments and any other costs incurred. Travel insurance is offered as protection for cancellations due to medical reasons such as illness or injury, please see TRAVEL INSURANCE. Travel insurance payments are non-refundable upon receipt. Tour participation is non-transferable. Names cannot be transferred on reservations or airline tickets. No refund will be made for any accommodations or services included in the tour that you do not use.

LATE RESERVATIONS: A \$25.00 late reservation fee and possible increase in airfare may apply for bookings received after the deposit deadline. All space is subject to availability and cannot be guaranteed past the deposit deadline noted on the brochure.

TRAVEL DOCUMENTS: All participants must have a valid passport. **U.S. Passports must be valid for at least six (6) months, subsequent to return date.** Special entry requirements for non-U.S. citizens may apply. Please consult the appropriate Consulate for current requirements. It is solely the passenger's responsibility to ensure that all documents needed are completed, current and in good condition. Peter's Way Tours will not be held responsible for lack of current and valid entry documents.

AIR TRANSPORTATION: Tentative round trip from **Chicago O'Hare Airport (subject to confirmation by October 30, 2019).** Flight itinerary and carrier may be subject to change. Departure taxes & fuel surcharges are estimated. They are determined solely by the airlines and are subject to increase prior to ticketing (approximately 30 days prior to departure).

AIRLINE SEATING: Under group airline reservations/contracts, the airlines will provide a block of seats for the group. Individual requests for seating preferences can only be made at time of check-in. Peter's Way cannot submit seating preferences as we cannot guarantee that any or all requests will be honored. If you require specific seating as a condition of your travel, it is suggested that you book your airfare individually and purchase the Land Only package. Upgrades to premium economy, business class, or first class may be available but oftentimes airlines will not allow the upgrades until time of ticketing (approximately 30 days prior to departure). Group reservations may not be accessible online for advance check-in/boarding passes/seat assignments. Airline guidelines vary. Please contact our office for specific details.

LAND ONLY PASSENGERS: Land Only packages do not include any portion of the group airfare. This includes any flights booked within the group itinerary. All airline tickets will be your responsibility to book independently. A passenger choosing the Land Only portion of the package (**pricing to be confirmed by October 30, 2019**) must notify Peter's Way Tours, in writing, at least 100 days prior to departure or a penalty fee will be assessed. Please be advised, passenger(s) opting for the Land Only package or who are deviating from the group itinerary will be responsible for their own transfers to/from hotel/airport. However, if you arrive at the same time or earlier than your group, you are welcome to join the group on the bus. It is recommended that you purchase your air transportation only after you have been notified that the group has materialized. If you purchase your own air transportation and the group does not materialize or you cancel your package for any reason, Peter's Way Tours will not be held responsible for the cost of your airfare or other arrangements booked independently.

DEVIATIONS & ITINERARY CHANGES: Peter's Way Tours is pleased to assist clients with changes in itineraries. All deviation requests must be submitted in writing at least 90 days prior to departure. Deviation fee will apply plus an airline change fee per person. Your routing and dates requested will determine if a difference in airfare will also apply. Not all carriers permit routing changes and/or deviations from the group itinerary. Please contact our office for information.

TRANSFERS AND PORTERAGE: Round-trip airport transfers are included for passengers who purchase the full air and land package. Porterage of one piece of luggage throughout your tour at hotels is also included.

ACCOMMODATIONS/SINGLE TRAVELERS: Price per person is based on two persons sharing twin bedded rooms with in hotels throughout your tour. Double bedded rooms for married couples are subject to availability and must be requested. Triple rooms may be available for family or friends traveling together. We discourage triple room accommodations because they are normally not spacious and there is no discount for triple occupancy. Triple rooms usually are regular twin or double bedded rooms with a rollaway bed added. **Single rooms may be requested at time of booking for an estimated additional charge of \$895.00. Single rooms in Oberammergau are extremely limited and can not be guaranteed. Double occupancy is required for arrangements in Oberammergau only.** While single rooms provide privacy, they are often smaller than twin bedded rooms and may be located away from the group in some hotels. We will make every effort (if you so desire) to match you with a same gender roommate when we receive your application, but we do not guarantee a roommate can be matched. If a single room must be assigned due to your roommate's cancellation, incompatibility or for any other reason (even at the last moment or while on tour), we must charge you the tour's single supplement or pro-rated amount.

MEALS: Buffet breakfast daily plus five dinners including a farewell Heurigen dinner with entertainment at a restaurant in Grinzing. Beverages are not included at set menu dinners.

GRATUITIES & SERVICE CHARGES: Gratuities are not included in your tour package. We recommend that you plan to bring 80.00 Euro for culturally acceptable tipping. For good work, recommended (but voluntary) tipping to your tour manager is 4.00 Euro per passenger per day; to the driver is 2.00 Euro per passenger per day; for the local guides 1.50 Euro per passenger per day. Tips for the tour manager and bus driver are normally given as a group at the end of the tour. Other gratuities are usually handled individually. All service charges and local taxes as imposed by hotels are included in the program rate. Although service charges are included, it is customary to leave 1.00 Euro per person for the waiters after each meal and 1.00 Euro per person per day for the maid/bell boys.
