## OUR FUNDRAISING GOAL NEARS COMPLETION



In 2011, we began a \$1.5 million dollar campaign to ask your support in restoring a great pipe organ. As of this date, the Patrons of Sacred Music have paid \$1,427,802 for the installation of our pipe organ, Casavant's

Op. 1130. We've nicknamed the organ "Tina Mae," after Tina Mae Haines, the concert organist who designed the organ with Casavant in 1926.

Beyond the \$1.5 million organ restoration goal, the Patrons raised \$350,000 to rebuild the upper organ loft and fortify it with solid steel. A generous donor made great sacrifices to keep the project on schedule. The balcony was near collapse, but with this construction complete, it now can hold "Tina Mae's" 23 tons. Beyond the restoration of the organ as a musical instrument, there are also costs for electrical work, rigging, scaffolding, etc. Your prayers and your financial generosity have made this monumental project possible. God reward you!
